| <p>We must verify your identity to comply with legal and regulatory requirements. We must verify the name, address and date of birth of our customers. We will use an electronic verification system to do this. We may also ask you to provide documentation.</p> <p><u>New customers</u></p> <p>We require proof of your identity, preferably in the form of a full UK or EU photo driving licence or a valid UK or EU passport. You will also need to supply a utility bill (not a mobile phone bill) which is less than three months old. If posting documents, please send certified copies.</p> <p>We will let you know if further documentation is required.</p> <p>If you are making an application online, you will also need your everyday bank or building society details, access to your email and mobile phone. We will ask some identity check questions.</p> <p><u>Existing customers</u></p> |

Don't usually need to provide identity documentation, but we will let you know if anything is required during the application process.

**How long do I have to make the first deposit?**

28 days. If you don't make a deposit to the account within 28 days of account opening, we will close the account in line with our General Conditions.

**How quickly do you process transactions by post?**

Where the account is operated by post, the Society will aim to deal with all transactions within two working days of receiving a request. We are not responsible for delays due to unforeseen circumstances and postal delays.

**The Financial Services Compensation Scheme**

We are a member of the Financial Services Compensation Scheme, the UK's deposit guarantee scheme. This means that your eligible deposits may be covered by the FSCS Scheme.
